Article 1 Basic Provisions

This Dean's Decision defines the amount of **regular merit scholarships** for study results obtained in the academic year 2020/2021 and thus supplements the Dean's Directive "SD/09/20 supplementing the TBU Scholarship Regulations", Article 3, paragraphs 5 and 6.

It also defines the amount of **extraordinary scholarship to support studies at FAI** for the academic year 2021/2022 according to the Dean's Directive "SD/06/18 - Rules for the Granting of an Extraordinary Scholarship to Foreign Students Studying in the Bachelor's and Master's Degree Studies Programmes in English at the Faculty of Applied Informatics", Article 2, paragraph 5.

Article 2 Amount of regular merit scholarships

The Dean of the Faculty of Applied Informatics (hereinafter referred to as the "FAI") decided on the following amounts of regular merit scholarships in study programs implemented at the FAI:

1. Study average ≥ 1.00 and at the same time ≤ 1.10	4,000 CZK / month
2. Study average > 1.10 and at the same time ≤ 1.30	2,000 CZK / month
3. Study average > 1.30 and at the same time <1.50	1,000 CZK / month

The merit scholarship is paid as a lump sum for ten months of study (September-June).

Article 3 Amount of extraordinary scholarship to support studies at FAI

The Dean of FAI decided that the amount of the extraordinary scholarship to support study at FAI for the academic year 2021/2022 for students enrolled in English study programs at FAI in the amount of 0,- CZK per month.

Article 4 Final Provisions

The amount of the scholarships was discussed and approved by the FAI Academic Senate at the meeting of the day 11. 10. 2021.
