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## Article 1 Introductory Provisions

The Dean's decree regulates the advancement of students in the first year of Bachelor's and Master's programmes to the second semester of study at the Faculty of Applied Informatics (hereinafter referred to as "FAI").

## Article 2 Conditions for Continuing Studies

According to the FAI internal regulation Rules for the Course of Study in Study Programmes Implemented at the Faculty of Applied Informatics, Article 16, paragraph 2, a **student in the first year of a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme** will advance to the second semester provided that he/she has **obtained at least 10 credits** by the end of the remedial examination period after the first semester, i.e. **by February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Credits gained through the recognition of courses taken in previous studies are not included in this limit.** The student will check in his/her own interest whether he/she has successfully completed all the study requirements registered in IS/ STAG.

A student who has **earned less than 10 credits will have his/her studies terminated** according to Section 56 (1) (b) of Act No. 101/1998 Coll. on Higher Education.

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
