## Article 1 Introductory Provisions

- (1) Students who have been graded with a grade of "F – Insufficient" in the defence part of the Bachelor's/Master's Thesis (hereinafter referred to as "BT/MT") or in the examinations in subjects of the State Final Examinations (hereinafter referred to as "SFE") have the possibility to retake the SFE in September 2026.
- (2) The student **must submit a written application** for the September 2026 SFE no later than **Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, to the Study Department of the Faculty of Applied Informatics (hereinafter referred to as "FAI"). The application form (General Request) is available on the faculty's website, direct link (after login): <https://fai.utb.cz/en/student-2/fai-students/study-forms/>.

## Article 2 Date of Resit SFE

**The date for the resit SFE is set for Wednesday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026.** Applicants who do not use this date will have the opportunity to defend their BT/MT and SFE in June 2027.

## Article 3 Duties of the student

Students wishing to participate in the September 2026 term of the SFE must complete the following obligations:

1. Students **who have failed in the regular term** of the SFE in the part "defence of the BT/MT and have been assessed in this part of the SFE with the grade "F - insufficient" shall deliver to the secretary of the institute administering the relevant study programme **a new signed BT/MT assignment document** created jointly with the thesis supervisor, in accordance with the recommendation of the SFE committee, no later than **Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. The assignment document should be created in Word using the following template: <https://fai.utb.cz/?mdocs-file=31213> (NOT in IS/STAG) **with highlighted changes from the original assignment!**

2. When submitting the assignment document, make an appointment to pick up the official BT/MT assignment from the department that administers the relevant degree program.
3. Students must **submit the application form for the SFE and BT/MT** with all the requirements according to the instructions for submitting the BT/MT no later than **Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026** according to the instructions on the FAI website (see StudentFAI / State Final Exams / The Resit Term of SFE (after registration). #### Article 4 Validity
